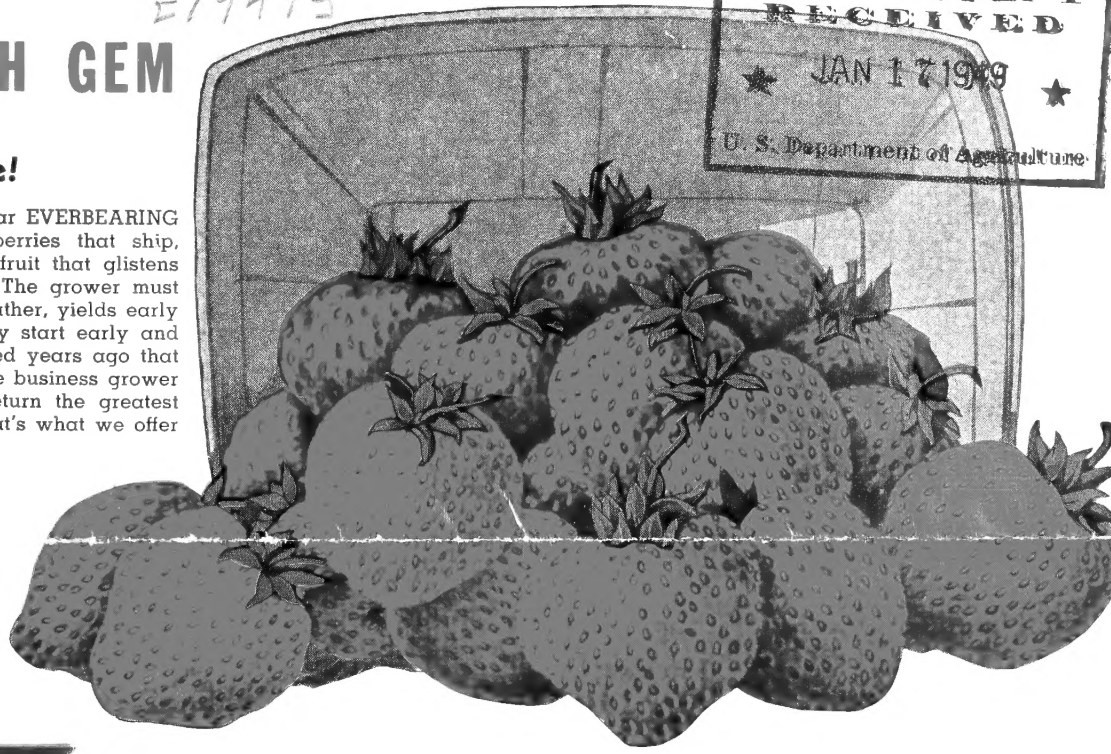
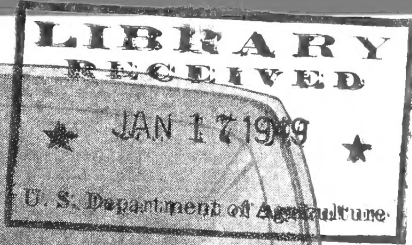

PEACHES

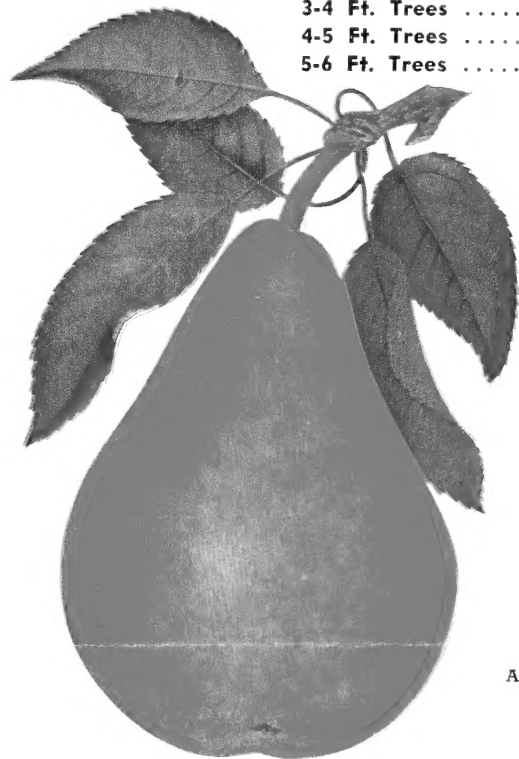
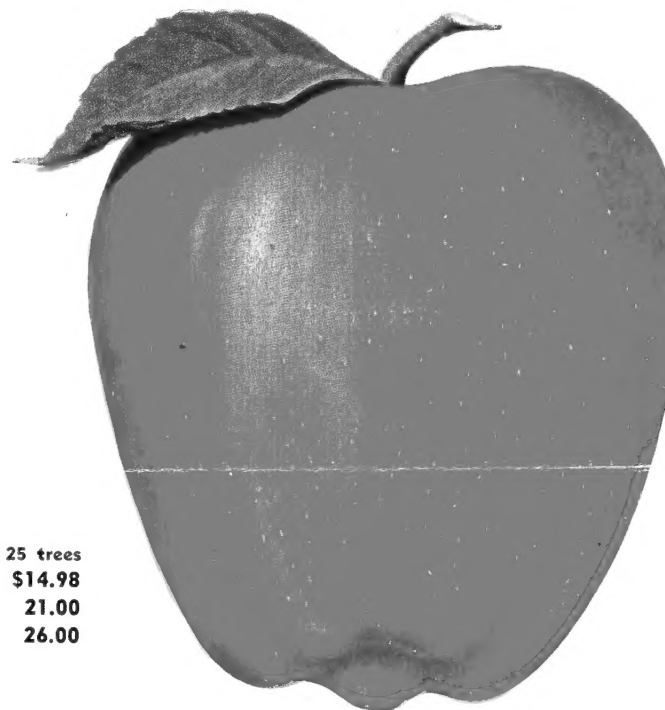

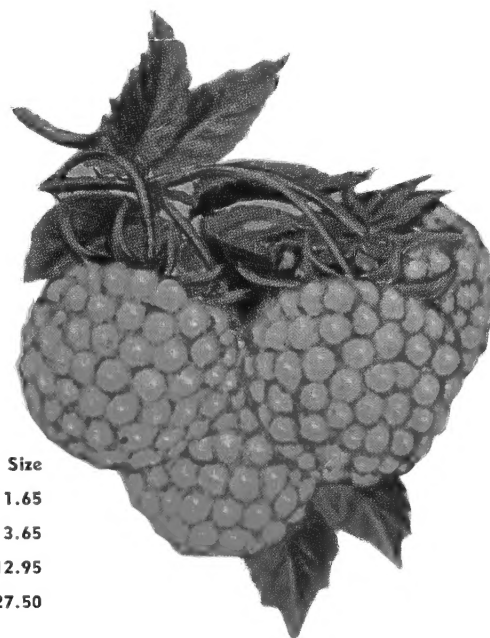
RASPBERRIES
